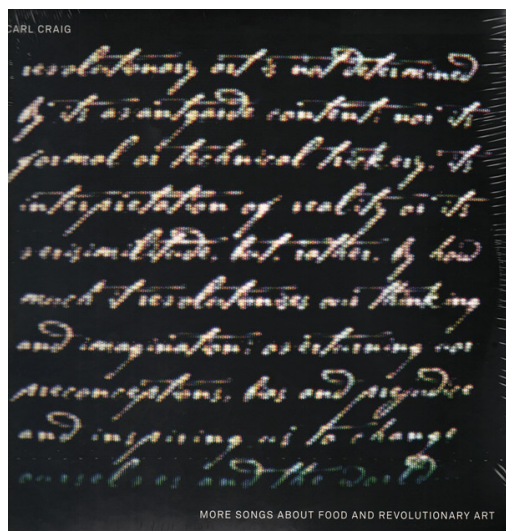

Rush Hour - you should be ASHAMED to be "raping" & "cashing in" on the success of this Detroit legend's work.
